- 6.1 **P/LBC/2024/02057** - Demolish and replace garden boundary wall. 31 Manor View House Salisbury Street Cranborne BH21 5PU. It was **PROPOSED** and **RESOLVED** to **SUPPORT** this application.
- 6.2 **P/FUL/2024/02056** - Demolish and replace garden boundary wall. 31 Manor View House Salisbury Street Cranborne BH21 5PU. It was **PROPOSED** and **RESOLVED** to **SUPPORT** this application.
- 6.3 **P/PAPA/2024/02506** - Construct sections of road for forestry use. Land at Old Claygrounds, Blackwater Plantation and Cranborne Common. From DC -The above application has been received. You are being notified for information purposes. This application is not a planning application but a request for the Council to determine whether or not Prior Approval is required for the proposal. **Noted by the PC.**

- 6.4 **P/OUT/2023/01166** - Mixed use development of up to 1,700 dwellings including affordable housing and care provision; 10,000sqm of employment space in the form of a business park; village centre with associated retail, commercial, community and health facilities; open space including the provision of suitable alternative natural green space (SANG); biodiversity enhancements; solar array, and new roads, access arrangements and associated infrastructure (Outline Application with all matters reserved apart from access off Hillbury Road).
