
THE CECIL MEMORIAL HALL

Finances:

The Village Hall runs at a loss and has done so for a number of years. Running costs are increasing with people who want to hire the hall decreasing. The hall has no savings to meet needed repairs—these could run to £100,000.



The forecast for this year, after contacting all regular users and realistically estimating the number of hirers, is that the hall will lose over £8,000.

Estimates:

The hall is currently unusable because the floor is unsafe. 7 companies were invited to provide estimates; 4 responded:

Like-for-like on suspended floor	£44,000 (plus VAT) – problem likely to recur
Polysafe wood-effect flooring (not suspended)	£20,000 (plus VAT)
Massimo vinyl plank flooring (not suspended)	£20,000 (plus VAT)
190mm lacquered oak flooring (not suspended)	£29,000 (plus VAT)

What are the options?

Option 1: Fund raise – who will do this, and what happens in the meantime?

Option 2: Close the hall and hand it back to the Parish Council as trustees.

Option 3: Ask the Parish Council to fund it through raising council tax and taking out a Public Work Loan

£100,000.00 Public Work Loan – need to be obtained by the PC		
Every household in Cranborne and Edmondsham would pay extra Council Tax as the PC would need to raise the precept to cover the loan repayments.		
10 year loan	£28.70	
20 year loan	£14.38	
30 year loan	£9.61	
40 year loan	£7.21	
50 year loan	£5.77
